Delaware Livestock Exposition Virtual Show Rules

1. Entries must be submitted electronically at the provided link from October 4, 2020 at 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on Sunday, October 11, 2020.
2. Entry fee is \$25.00 per entry for all species.
3. Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or under as of October 11, 2020.
4. This show is open to exhibitors from any state.
5. All videos should be horizontal format and between 60-90 seconds. Do not alter raw video with overlays, filters, etc.
6. The video should show all views and angles of the animal. The animal should be seen both stopped and on the move.
7. Animals should be presented in the video as they would at a traditional show.
8. All registered stock are required to provide an animal name, registration number and DOB at entry.
9. Commercial stock are required to provide an animal name and declared weight at entry. (Cannot be shown in breed class)
10. Results will be emailed to exhibitors and announced on our Facebook page after judging concludes.
11. Provide a correct mailing address, email address and phone number to receive premiums, results, etc.
